

ANKYLOSING SPONDYLITIS RESEARCH GRANT

The Arthritis National Research Foundation (ANRF) mission is to provide initial research funding to brilliant, investigative scientists with new ideas to cure Arthritis and related Autoimmune Diseases.

Purpose: The Arthritis National Research Foundation (ANRF) is seeking grant applications that focus on the study of Ankylosing Spondylitis.

Applicants: Applicants must be newer M.D. and/or Ph.D. applicants at early stages in their career. (equivalent to assistant professor/instructor/senior post-docs).

Budget and Project Period: Applicants may request up to \$100,000 in direct costs only. The project period is one year, with the option to apply for a second year if significant progress is demonstrated. The grant period is June 1 to May 31. In 2021, priority is given to applicants with no prior funding from ANRF.

Application: The research grant application is supported by proposalCENTRAL. All policies and guidelines can be found by visiting CureArthritis.org/grants

Submission Deadline: Applications must be submitted online by **Sunday, January 17, 2021**.

Review Process: Submitted applications will be evaluated by an expert panel of peer reviewers and the award will be announced no later than May 15, 2021.
